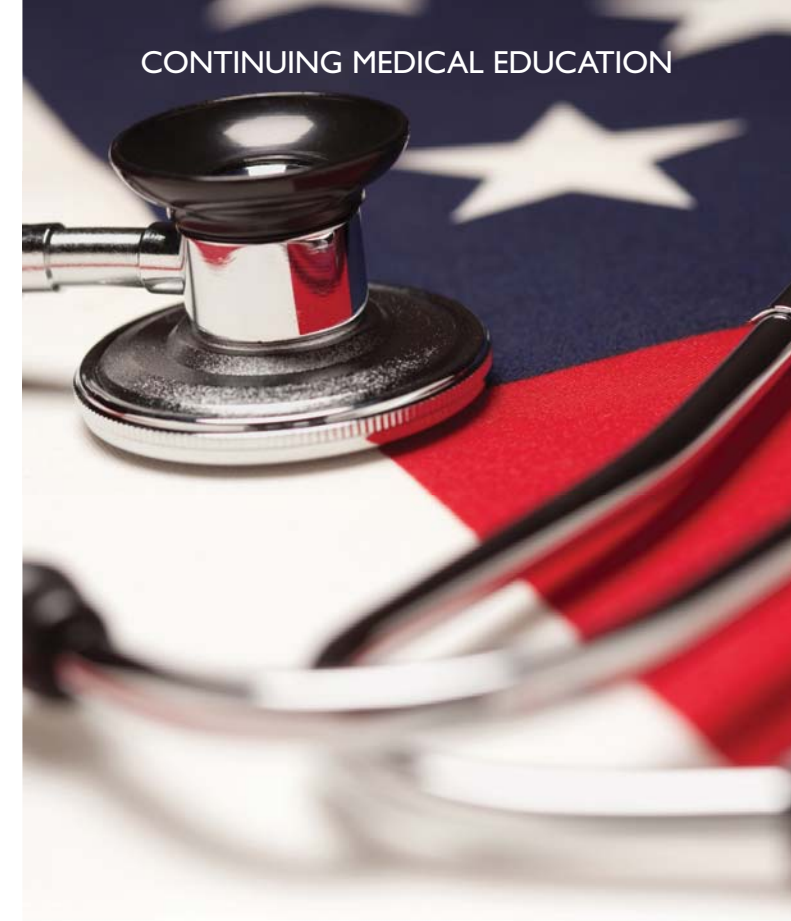

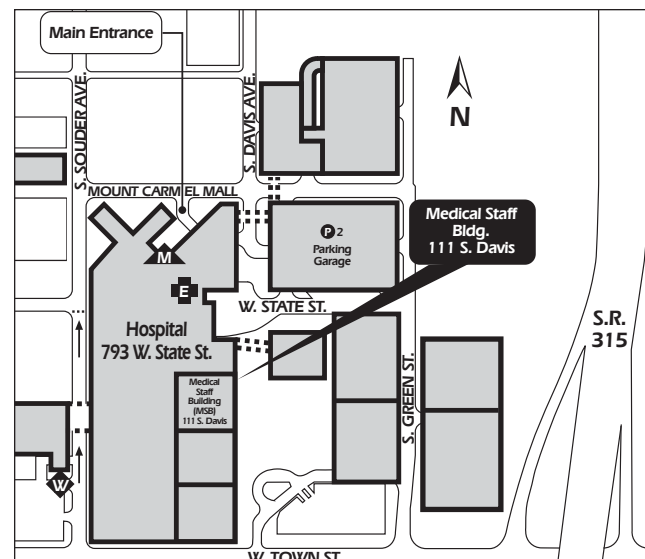
Mount Carmel West is located just west of downtown Columbus, with convenient access to the hospital via major routes and interstates.
